Yokohama Dance Collection EX, the largest contemporary dance festival in Japan, has launched the careers of many choreographers since it was founded in 1996 to nurture young choreographers and popularize contemporary dance. In 2013, the 18th of these festivals will be held in Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse No. 1, which will be celebrating the centennial of its completion. Now the selection of the finalists who will perform there for both divisions, Competition I: Dance Competition Division and Competition II: New Choreographers, has been completed.

Competition I: Performance Division

The Dance Competition Division (Competition I) attracted 124 entries from Korea, Japan, the Philippines, Hungary, Taiwan - China. Based on videos the entrants submitted, 12 finalists, from Japan, Korea, and Taiwan, have been selected to perform before the judges during the festival. These are talented, daring choreographers who stretch themselves and expand their creative worlds, approaching dance from innovative points of view. On the last day of the festival, Kazumasa TAKAHASHI, who won the Outstanding New Artist Prize in the New Choreographer Division (Competition II) in 2012, will perform his new work.

Competition II: New Choreographer Division

The New Choreographers Division (Competition II), now in its third year, is open to choreographers who are 25 and under. This year, the average age of the 40 groups of entrants was 22.6 and the youngest 18. These choreographers from a wide variety of backgrounds, including street dance, ballet, and juggling, have presented innovative, daring work. The 15 finalists chosen from among them will perform during the festival. Look forward to the gleam and raw power of their fresh, still unrefined performances.

Yokohama Dance Collection EX2013 Program Schedule

The rich 2013 festival program will include the competitions, winners' performances, the Contemporary Dance Showcase, the overseas festival exchange program, and the presentation of new work by a winner of Competition II (a component of the program initiated at Yokohama Dance Competition EX 2011).

The overseas festival exchange program will include two performances. Choreographer Kawamura Mikiko, a Yokohama Dance Collection EX 2011 prizewinner, will take part in a performance resulting from a joint project with the Jojo-Oulu Dance Centre of Finland, which was launched this year. Suzuki Yuriko, winner of the Jury Prize in Yokohama Dance Collection EX 2012, will perform in *Dance Connection*, a joint project with the Seoul Performing Arts Festival, which was initiated last year.

In addition, the Yokohama Dance Collection Winner's Performance and Dance Connection will be held in cooperation with the TPAM Performing Arts Meeting in Yokohama 2013. With many directors of theaters and dance festivals overseas coming to Japan for the festival, the 2013 performing arts year kicks off with a bound in Yokohama!
